## 5.1 Shipping Pigeons - Air Canada (CCRPC Victoria BC)

The Capital City Racing Pigeon Club, Victoria BC has asked that the CRPU try to negotiate with Air Canada with respect to the shipping of pigeons by air. There are no issues with using West Jet but Air Canada uses guidelines set down by IATA Live Animal Regulations. These guidelines which include the requirement for a perch do not meet the needs of the birds.

Terry agreed to write a letter to ascertain the rules/regulations required to ship pigeons by air.

## 5.4 By Law Update (Steve)

**Town of Cornwall** – Past President Mike van der Jagt is presenting our concerns before Cornwall Council this evening.

**Township of Woolwich** – the Shannon's await a response from the township acknowledging their most recent correspondence.

**Town of Amherstburg -** Our good friend Carlo Bertolissio, President of the Windsor Invitational RPC professionally represented our interests before Council on October 29, 2012. We understood that matter was referred back to Staff that evening. That has not happened. Staff moved quickly the next day trying to pressure the Taylors to apply for a zoning change to allow them to keep their birds. A cheque for \$2000 must be submitted with that application. This is not a reasonable solution. An application to change a residential lot into agriculture zoning will fail. Stand by for more on this front.

At the National level we maintain the band registry system but that does not include AU, IF birds or birds lost from One Loft Races. It was decided this is an Educational piece best addressed before our next racing season. Terry volunteered to write an article for the January Newsletter.
